### Award Committee

- Chaired by current SCCR President
- 2 other committee members, appointed by SCCR President (from 2 different disciplines)
- Committee members are recused from voting for nominees with whom they have a clear conflict of interest (personal/professional relationship with nominee)
- Award committee membership changes each year

### Award Details

The award may not necessarily be given each year; it is contingent upon nominations.

- Plaque
- Award presentation at annual conference banquet dinner
- Free registration and banquet fees for SCCR conference

### Eligibility

Demonstrated dedication to the Society for Cross-Cultural Research and career-long contributions to cross-cultural research that have substantially influenced the nominee's discipline and its development. This award seeks to recognize the work of those individuals whose involvement in cross-cultural research has had an impact on the wider visibility and relevance of such work and on the growth of a community of scholarship addressing issues in one or more of the following fields: Anthropology, Psychology, Sociology, or related fields (such as Education, Family Studies, Social Work, Human Development, etc).

### Nominations Process

- The Executive Committee of SCCR invites the membership to submit nominees for this prestigious award
- Nomination must include a supporting letter outlining the nominee's contributions to SCCR and cross-cultural research
- Self-nominations will not be accepted at this time
- Award must be received in person at the annual conference banquet
